Till September 2024, 7.523 new individuals were registered (new and continuous registrations) by UNHCR. Among them 787 children were registered and provided with documentation. 3.571 RSD individual decisions were adjudicated, and 259 government officials were trained.

Several meetings with the key national partners, such as the MASEF and the Direction of the Centers for the Protection and Social Inclusion of the Child (CPISE in French) were organized by IOM. The dissemination of the National Referral Mechanism (NRM) and the creation of the Counter Trafficking (CT) units at the CPISE centers were discussed. Since the start of project, 2 local NGOs that will collaborate closely with the CPISE and the Direction of Childhood to consolidate the foster families' system established in 2022 were selected and 92 families officially validated. 57 families have received socio-economic support (incomegenerating activities - IGA-, cash-based intervention, etc) according to their needs and 50 children have received alternative care according to their needs and best interest. 70 CPISE staff attended the 4 training sessions on registration and monitoring of cases.
